

# Safe Routes to School (SRTS) May 2009 Report

## Summary

Major events included the spring Walk to School Day (May 13), Bike to Work Week activities (May 4–15), and Traffic Skills 101 course for PE teachers (May 21-22), and the Nevada Bicycle and Pedestrian Conference (May 20-21). The bicycle safety education program was observed and assisted.

## Coordination

- participated in Bike to Work Week planning and implementation with SRTS partner Muscle Powered
- attended and assisted Bike II education course in Palo Alto to develop expertise in middle school bicycle education programs

## Education

- developed and instructed Traffic Skills 101 course on May 21-22, which graduated five elementary PE Specialists and ten other community members
- observed and assisted bicycle safety education programs at Seeliger ES and Bordewich ES
- participated in Nevada Bicycle and Pedestrian Conference for two days; presented on CCSD - CCPW partnership with Patrick Pittenger

## Encouragement

- successful Spring Walk to School Day on May 13 for five elementary schools and two middle schools; two articles in the Nevada Appeal; distribution of incentives at two schools
- received and distributed bicycle helmets for Bordewich ES
- ordered all incentives and received a portion of them

## Enforcement

- no significant action; purchase of speed display signs by Carson City Public Works is awaiting go ahead from NDOT and contract between CCPW and CCSD

## Evaluation

- provided “Survey About Walking and Biking to School” (parent survey) to Bordewich ES; submitted completed “Survey About Walking and Biking to School” (parent survey) from Seeliger ES to national database

## Engineering

- no significant action; awaiting acceptance of Engineering element budget revision and stewardship review from NDOT
