

SRTS Multi-use Path for Eagle Valley MS

This project would connect the existing Route 6 multi-use path at Moffat Open Space with Lepire Dr to the north. The connection opens two major neighborhoods, River Knolls & Empire Ranch Subdivisions, which provide students to Eagle Valley Middle School, to Hells Bells Road which in turn connects to the school.

We do not have firm numbers on the number of active walkers and bicyclers in the neighborhoods, nor the potential number of students, but on a recent count day with snow on the ground, snow falling, and unusually low temperatures, there were 22 students going home along the future route of the multi-use path, 5 bicyclists and 17 walkers. Parents have expressed concern that the current unpaved route is too unknown, so creation of a high standard path will lessen parent concerns about safety.

The path will be about one quarter mile long. It has already been designed by Carson City Public Works and Carson City Parks and Recreation. The Open Space Program has allocated \$25K to the project, and another \$25K is necessary to bring to construct the project. Funds from the Safe Routes to School grant will match the existing funding.
